
Submission Deadline: December 20, 2023

- * Submitted Photo Properties
 - Size: 1024px by 1024px or larger
 - Format: JPG
 - Be free of watermarks or anything that will identify the photographer

 - Photographer first and last name
 - Photo's main subject
 - Date taken
 - Location Taken (Name of country and region)
 - Equipment Used
 - A brief description of the image processing

2023 RASC Mississauga Astrophotography Contest:

Divisions:

• Master Class:

This category is reserved for photos that exhibit a high level of experience, more expensive equipment, and more complicated technical details to produce.

• General:

Photos in this category are comprised of more entry level skills and equipment and generally require less technical skills to produce than those accepted to the Master Class division.

• Youth:

This division is limited to members of 25yrs and younger on the date of the submission deadline of December 20, 2023.

Categories:

• Solar System:

Photos of any solar system objects where the main subject is not Earth. This includes Sol, Luna, planets, comets, and asteroids.

• Deep Sky Objects (DSO):

Photos where any deep sky object (DSO) is the main subject of the photo. The DSO need not take up the majority of the photographed area. This can include Messier, NGC, and Asterism targets.

• Astroscape:

Astroscapes must contain an astronomical object, or objects, while including the landscape. The photo can be taken at any time of day, but must be of astronomical interest to set it apart from typical landscape snapshots in order to be considered.
